Introduction

This article explores ten key things to know about PRINCE2 Agile exams. If you have already decided to get qualified in <u>PRINCE2 Agile</u> this article is for you.

1. Studying for PRINCE2 Agile exams

Understanding the material is the first step in successfully passing the PRINCE2 Agile exam. It requires you to review the official PRINCE2 Agile manual to understand the PRINCE2 methodology, as well as the agile concepts, agile targets, behaviours, focus areas, and how these can be applied using PRINCE2. Reading, working through mock exam papers, and using other study aids are also needed.

The best (and quickest) way to study for your PRINCE2 Agile exams is by taking accredited <u>PRINCE2 Agile</u> training. If you take accredited training, you will receive PRINCE2 Agile exam vouchers redeemable within 12 months.

2. Booking PRINCE2 Agile exams

Booking the PRINCE2 Agile exams is an important step of the process. When you feel confident in your knowledge and understanding of PRINCE2 Agile, you can schedule your exam. This step sets a target date to base your studies around.

When scheduling your exam, be sure to consider these two pieces of advice:



1. Opt for a date that allows you a few days prior for review. It's not advisable to take an exam if your last study session was a week or two earlier.

2. Aim to schedule your exam in the morning hours. Research indicates that cognitive functions are often at their peak during this time.

To book your exam, you have two options: You can either get in touch with the Accredited Training Organization (ATO) from which you received your training, or you can directly contact the PRINCE2 examination body, PeopleCert.

3. Preparing for PRINCE2 Agile exams

Preparing for your exams involves more than just studying; it also includes planning your study schedules, understanding the exam format, and learning effective methods to answer exam questions. By preparing for the PRINCE2 Agile exams, you set yourself up for success, ensuring you cover all necessary content and build your confidence.

4. Revising for PRINCE2 Agile exams

Preparation for the PRINCE2 Agile exams involves thorough reviewing of the PRINCE2 Agile manual, course notes, and other study resources to ensure everything is fresh in your mind. This step also includes taking practice exams repeatedly until you are consistently achieving scores above the passing grade.

This step should be done near the exam date and aims to solidify your knowledge, clear up any misunderstandings, and increase your confidence to sit the exam.

5. Registering for PRINCE2 Agile exams

The registration process means that you enrol with PeopleCert (the official examination body), provide the necessary information, and accept the terms and conditions. Once completed for the Foundation exam, you can gain access to the official online PRINCE2 manual. For this reason, this might be one of the first steps you need to do.

6. Understanding PRINCE2 Agile exams

Comprehending the structure, format, and style of the PRINCE2 Agile exams is a foundational step in the entire process and is vital for effective preparation and successful performance. This includes acquainting oneself with the nature of the questions, scoring system, and the scope and depth of the content involved. The most effective way to grasp these details for both exams is to thoroughly study the <u>Foundation</u> and <u>Practitioner</u> syllabi.

7. Taking the PRINCE2 Agile exams

Taking the PRINCE2 Agile exams is the culmination of the previous steps. This involves the actual sitting of the exam, under timed conditions. It's the part of the process where your knowledge and understanding of PRINCE2 Agile is formally evaluated.

8. Passing PRINCE2 Agile exams

To pass your PRINCE2 Agile exams is probably your most important goal. This is the desired outcome of the previous steps. It represents your successful understanding of PRINCE2 Agile (Foundation exam) and application of PRINCE2 Agile (Practitioner exam).

Passing the exam results in the award of a <u>PRINCE2 Agile certificate</u> at either <u>Foundation</u> or <u>Practitioner</u> levels.

9. Acing PRINCE2 Agile exams

Acing the PRINCE2 Agile exams goes beyond simply passing; it represents a good understanding and application of <u>PRINCE2</u>. It is the aspirational goal for many candidates and may often require more intensive preparation and study.

Excelling in the PRINCE2 Agile exams goes beyond just achieving a passing score; it signifies a strong understanding and effective application of the <u>PRINCE2 Agile method</u>. Acing the exams is the aim for many candidates and may typically demand more extensive preparation and studying.

10. Buying PRINCE2 Agile exams only

For students who have purchased accredited training, they should already possess an exam voucher(s). If a candidate lacks an exam voucher, there are two methods to acquire one:

1. Purchase an exam directly from PeopleCert.

2. Purchase an exam directly from an ATO.

Typically, the second option is the most cost-effective method to purchase only the exam.

FAQs about PRINCE2 Agile exams

Are PRINCE2 Agile exams difficult?

Whether the PRINCE2 Agile exams are difficult is usually a subjective opinion. Pass rates are a similar level to the standard PRINCE2 exams. In the UK, 99% of Knowledge Train students pass their <u>PRINCE2 Agile</u> Foundation exam first time, and 87% of Knowledge Train students pass their <u>PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner</u> exam first time.

Can you take PRINCE2 Agile exams online?

Yes. Both the PRINCE2 Agile Foundation and Practitioner exams can be sat online. However, for incompany training delivered by an accredited training organization, paper-based exams can still be taken.

How hard are PRINCE2 Agile exams?

Students typically say that the PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner exam is harder than the PRINCE2 Agile Foundation exam.

In the UK, Knowledge Train's students achieved a pass rate for the <u>PRINCE2 Agile Foundation exam</u> of 99%, and an 87% pass rate for the <u>PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner exam</u>.

How long is the PRINCE2 Agile exam?

PRINCE2 Agile exams are the same duration as regular PRINCE2 exams. That's 60 minutes for Foundation, and 150 minutes for Practitioner.

How long are the PRINCE2 Agile exams?

The <u>PRINCE2 Agile Foundation exam</u> is 60 minutes. The <u>PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner exam</u> is 150 minutes. Extra time is available for students sitting the exam in a non-native language.

For example, if a candidate sits an exam in English, but their mother tongue is French, they can claim 25% additional time.

Candidates claiming additional time will have 75 minutes to sit the Foundation exam, and 188 minutes to sit the Practitioner exam.

How much do PRINCE2 Agile exams cost?

The cost of PRINCE2 Agile exams varies between countries, and between ATOs (accredited training organizations).

If bought from an ATO, the PRINCE2 Agile exam is usually purchased as part of an <u>accredited course</u>, but some ATOs also sell the exam as an 'exam-only' option.

The price always changes so it is best to check out <u>PRINCE2 Agile Foundation courses</u> or <u>PRINCE2 Agile</u> <u>Practitioner courses</u>.

Are PRINCE2 Agile exams open book?

<u>PRINCE2 Agile Foundation exams</u> are closed book, so no study materials or papers are allowed on a candidate's desk during the exam.

<u>PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner exams</u> are open book, so the candidate is allowed to use the official PRINCE2 Agile manual during the exam.

What are the prerequisites for the PRINCE2 Agile exams?

There are no prerequisites for taking the PRINCE2 Agile Foundation exam. However, to sit the PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner exam, candidates must already hold a current qualification in any of the following:

- PRINCE2 Agile Foundation.
- Any PRINCE2 certification.
- Project Management Professional (PMP)[®].
- Certified Associate in Project Management (CAPM)®.
- IPMA[®] Levels A, B, C, or D.

Where do I take a PRINCE2 Agile exam?

PRINCE2 Agile exams are taken online from a location of your choosing. Most students take their exam at home.

For organization's which conduct in-company training from an accredited training organization the exam can be taken as a paper exam and sat at the training location.
